


From October 31st to November 3rd, 2018, the Third A3 Roundtable Meeting on Chemical Probe Research Hub was held in Lotte City Hotel at Jeju, Korea. The meeting was sponsored by Korea National Research Foundation (NRF), National Natural Science Foundation of China (NSFC), and Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS) along with Seoul National University, Korea. Professor Seung Bum Park from Seoul National University of Korea, Professor Jianhua Qi from Zhejiang University of China, and Professor Minoru Ueda from Tohoku University of Japan were the chairmen of this meeting.



There were 11 keynote presentations, 41 oral presentations, and 38 short presentations along with poster presentation at this meeting. The

participants of this 3rd A3 Roundtable meeting are 52 principal investigators (PIs) and 38 graduate students/postdoc



from China, Japan, and Korea. This A3 meeting is building up the tradition that all participants including graduate students make oral presentations in front of world-famous chemical biologists, which is quite challenging but extremely important for next generation scientists. This meeting was designed to promote academic exchanges and collaboration among scientists from China, Japan and



Korea in the field of chemical biology. Along with scientific presentations, all participants had a change to enjoy excellent foods, beautiful nature of Jeju island (Hamduk beach and Sangunburi), and delicious beer/soju. We believe

that all participants had memorable experience with good memory in science and friendship. It is worth mentioning that this A3 meeting provided a platform and opportunity of communication and collaborations for young scientists in the field of chemical biology.
